Membership Agreement and Waiver of Claims

ARTICLE III. CLASSES AND TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

The benefits and entitlements for the various classes and types of membership, as may be amended from time to time, are set forth in The Alaska Club Member Handbook and online at www.thealaskaclub.com.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Nature of Membership. Membership is a non-transferable right which confers on Member the sole right to use and enjoy the Club facilities in accordance with the rules and regulations as adopted and/or amended by the Club.

Section 2. Nondiscrimination. The Club accepts membership applications from any individual, family or business organization of good character and responsible credit background without regard to race, creed, color, sex or national origin.

Section 3. Prior Membership Contingency. Any applicant who was a prior member of the Club will be asked to verify that their prior membership termination was done while the member was in good standing. New membership is contingent on member satisfying any prior unpaid debt retained by the Club and any sums paid shall first be applied to the remaining unpaid debt.

ARTICLE V. ENROLLMENT FEES, DUES AND CHARGES Section 1. Fees.

- (a) Enrollment Fee. All new members shall pay an enrollment fee to the Club. The amount, manner and time of payment of such fee shall be established by the Club and may be changed from time to time. No portion of such fee will be refunded if a member withdraws or downgrades the membership. If a member has elected a membership with a 12-month initial term, they may upgrade by signing a new agreement for the remainder of their membership term. This will increase the cancellation fee to the upgrade level. If no term commitment is in effect, a membership may be upgraded by signing a new one-year agreement or paying \$35.00.
- (b) Annual Fee. All new members will be assessed an Annual Fee of \$34.00 commencing sixty (60) days after they become a member. This assessment will appear on a member's monthly billing statement for the month the initial Annual Fee is due and then annually thereafter on the anniversary month of the initial assessment.
- **Section 2. Dues.** Monthly dues vary by region and membership classification. Members agree to pay dues based upon the location of their primary residence or primary use. The obligation to pay dues is not dependent on the availability of all the Club's facilities. Dues will not be reduced or suspended during the time when one or more of the facilities are not available. Annual increases in dues will generally occur in October of each year.
- (a) Leave of Absence. With appropriate documentation from their physician, members may apply for a leave of absence if they are unable to use the Club because of prolonged illness or injury. Members may apply for a business leave, in writing and in advance, with satisfactory proof from their employer. The dues of members on leave of absence shall be established by the Club and may be changed from time to time.
- **Section 3. Charges.** Member, co-applicant and dependents, may use an approved credit card on file to purchase any non-recurring Club goods and services. Credit terms may be changed as warranted.
- (a) Online Services System. The Club has an Online Services System where a member is able to electronically pay dues and charges, access Club services and commit the member to services or other Club amenities (such as court reservations) without personal interaction with Club staff. Member understands and agrees that by using the Club's Online Services System, member will be bound by any such electronic commitment pursuant to the terms and conditions of this membership agreement and as set forth in the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (AS 09.80.010 et seq.) until such time as the member withdraws, in writing, from the Club's Online Services System.

ARTICLE VI. RULES, REGULATIONS AND POLICIES (collectively "Policies")

Section 1. Publication and Access. The Club has adopted Policies for use of Club facilities which all members and guests are expected to honor as a part of this membership agreement. Policies may vary by Club location and are set forth in The Alaska Club Member Handbook and online at www.thealaskaclub.com.

Section 2. Changes. The Club may amend or adopt other Policies. New Policies or policy amendments will be published in the Member Handbook as it is periodically updated. All current Policies are available online at www.thealaskaclub.com.

ARTICLE VII. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Voluntary Resignation. Member may resign from The Alaska Club by giving 60 days advance written notice to the Club and paying all dues or other charges outstanding. Voluntary resignation shall not be deemed effective until after the expiration of the 60-day notice period and after all required payments have been made to the Club. Subsequent to voluntary resignation, the member shall not be subject to any further dues or other charges. Non-use of the Club is not considered notice of cancellation. Section 2. Involuntary Termination. The Club reserves the right at any time to terminate the membership of any member for failure to comply with any Policy adopted by the Club or for any conduct the Club determines to be contrary to the best interests of the Club. The membership may be terminated by notification in writing mailed by the Club to the first address shown on the records of the Club for the member being terminated. A terminated member will remain liable for all dues and other indebtedness incurred prior to the effective cancellation date. The membership of any member who is 60 days in arrears with respect to the payment of his/her account to the Club may, at the Club's option, be terminated.

ARTICLE VIII. APPLICANT'S MEMBERSHIP IS SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE CLUB.

All applications and Agreements shall be on Club forms and shall be subject to payment of the required enrollment fees and approval of the Club. Persons under the age of 18 must have the signature of a parent or guardian assuming financial liability for membership and waiver of claims for the minor. By signing this document, the applicant(s) are stating that all information provided for membership is true and correct to the best of their knowledge. This agreement with attachments contains the entire agreement between the Club and the member and may not be modified verbally by any employee.
